education, engage people in practical actions and mobilize ourselves quickly when the need arises. The concept is much like cell groups or networking businesses. People will host MTP in their communities gathering 20-25 freinds, family members or neighbors. The meetings should last 45-60min and result in another MTP.

There are different types of MTPs, Issue MTPs that will address specific topics that are area sensitive like in NWA the issue of millage increase or Cap-n-Trade and it's effects on the citizens of Arkansas. Candidate Recruitment MTPs will be held similar to a Town Hall meeting. Candidates will have a chance to address the people and allow voters to make informed decisions. Then there will be Training MTPs which will assist citizens in becoming engaged in the system and having it work for the people.

As we develop this model other MTPs will focus on ballot initiatives and outreaches. If you have MTP ideas we welcome your input.
